has made over 100 tours on five continents. Poland is one of the European Union's strongest countries

economically and has come into prominence as a major European cultural center and an ally of the

United States. With major support from the Taube and Koret Foundations, Warsaw will be the venue of

the 2013 opening of the Museum of the History of Polish Jews, a landmark institution that will exhibit

the 1,000-year Jewish history of Greater Poland, acknowledged to be a foundation of Judeo-Christian

Western Culture.
